Sharing personal data with third parties

Store-IT only provides personal data to third parties if this is necessary for the performance of our agreement with you or to comply with a legal obligation.

Cookies or similar technologies used by Store-IT

Store-IT uses technical and functional cookies. A cookie is a small text file that is stored on your computer, tablet, or smartphone when you first visit this website.

The cookies we use are necessary for the technical operation of the website and your ease of use. They ensure that the website functions properly and, for example, remember your preference settings. We may also use them to optimize our website.

You can opt out of cookies by setting your internet browser to no longer store cookies. In addition, you can delete all previously stored information via your browser settings.

reCAPTCHA

Store-IT uses the reCAPTCHA service of Google Inc. (Google) to protect our website against spam and abuse.

To enable Google reCAPTCHA to function, the IP address of a website visitor, mouse movements, and possibly other data are collected. This information is transmitted to and processed by Google. By analyzing this data, Google can determine whether the visitor is a genuine user or a robot.

Accessing, modifying, or deleting data

You have the right to access, correct, or delete your personal data. You also have the right to withdraw any consent you have given for data processing or to object to the processing of your personal data by Store-IT. In addition, you have the right to data portability.

To ensure that the request for access has been made by you, we ask you to include a copy of your identity document with your request. In this copy, please black out your passport photo, MRZ (machine readable zone, the strip with numbers at the bottom of the passport), passport number, and Citizen Service Number (BSN). This is to protect your privacy.

We will respond to your request as quickly as possible, but within four weeks at the latest.
